(Hamburg, March 16, 2016) Following last year's successful premiere, the International School of Hamburg (ISH) once again presents multi-faceted works of art as part of its annual IB Arts Exhibition. On Wednesday March 16 (4pm-6pm) the interested public has the unique opportunity to lionize paintings, installation and photographs created by 10 talented Visual Arts course graduates over the course of two years. Admission is free.

Anyone curious about valuable, creative and internationally-minded art cannot afford to miss this very special exhibition: Students from different cultural backgrounds showcase about 100 works they have created over the course of their two-year long artistic journey within the framework of their chosen core subject "Visual Arts", which is a vital part of their IB Diploma and final grade. The key goal of the programme is to encourage students to actively discover art in an international and intercultural context and to prepare them for studying the subject at university level.

"This year we focused on fusing theory and practice. The students documented their own creative process and how it was influenced by famous artists", ISH Art Teacher Gundula Plesch explains. "Their work was guided by their involvement in various themes such as identity, fantasy worlds, discovery of colors, expression of emotions, fragility and vulnerability, youth culture as well as self expression and transformation."

With 4,000+ participating schools, the International Baccalaureate (IB) represents the most popular educational system worldwide, while the IB Diploma serves as an entry qualification to top universities around the globe. The strictly English speaking curriculum puts a focus on team work, communications and project work and prepares its students for a world of employment characterized by rapid change.
