### Philharmonic Orchestra from Shanghai delivers guest performance

(Hamburg, 18 September 2015) An exclusive concert awaits fans of classical music at the International School of Hamburg: On Friday 2 October (starting 19:00) the "Jincai Experimental Middle School Philharmonic Orchestra" of Hamburg's twin city Shanghai will pay come to visit. The 59-strong student ensemble will perform pieces of internationally renowned composers for both school community and general public. Entry to the concert is free of charge.

During their concert at ISH, the talented young musicians (ages 11-15) will demonstrate their skills on the cello, violin, viola, trombone, clarinet, oboe, horn, tuba, contrabass, and cross flute. The roster consists of pieces by composers from various eras:

- Lin Liu: Carousel
- Andrew Lloyd Webber: The Phantom of the Opera
- Jianzhong Wang: Red Flowers Blooming all over the Mountain
- Randy Back: The Mexican Clarinet
- Dmitri Schostakowitsch: Suite für Jazzorchester
- Johann Pachelbel: Canon in D
- Huan Liu: Phoenix in Love

The Shanghai Jincai Experimental Middle School Philharmonic Orchestra's performance at ISH (conducted by Mr Lin Liu) is only the beginning of the ensemble's very first visit to Germany. The next items on the itinerary are a participation in the "Orchestrale 2015", a well known competition taking place in Hamburg and Schleswig-Holstein, and subsequent visits to the cities of Berlin and Leipzig. The excursion was made possible by the Hamburg-based travel specialist China Tours, which is highly engaged in music and student exchanges between Germany and China. The Middle School from Shanghai was among the company's very cooperation partners.

The Chinese guests will already arrive on 1 October. As a result they will be able to rehearse and gain insights into the varied classes held at ISH. Mr Andrew Cross, ISH's Secondary School Principal comments on the visit as follows: "The International School of Hamburg is delighted to host the Philharmonic Orchestra of the Jincai Experimental Middle School in Shanghai. We welcome this opportunity for cultural exchange and invite all music lovers to join us at this event. The International School of Hamburg is committed to an internationally-minded approach to education and the fostering of closer ties among nations. Music is a universal language and we are very pleased to present this special concert to the Hamburg community."
