Your general responsibilities will be:

- Ensure the efficient and safe operation of the After School Care and Camp programmes
- Communicate student behavior concerns to the ECC/JS Assistant Principal and Principal
- Promote and develop the programme in conjunction with the ECC/Junior School Assistant Principal, ECC Coordinator and ECC/JS Principal
- Carry out day to day administrative tasks in collaboration with the Assistants and Helpers
- Be aware of and comply with all health and safety requirements
- Manage, supervise and coach all staff, volunteers and contractors enlisted to assist with the programme
- Ensure all staff involved in these programme participate in the annual Child Safeguarding training led by our Safeguarding Officer
- Ensure that policies and procedures are in place to ensure the safety of both staff and children
- Ensure that any accidents and incidents are recorded and reported to the school nurse and and to the ECC/Junior School Principal
- Understand all emergency procedures and be able to take control in an emergency
- Develop and participate in a team approach encouraging and offering support to the children
- Lead and participate in activities as outlined in the programme plan
- Ensure that the children have a positive experience and that their families are comfortable and satisfied with the care they are receiving
- Train new staff through an induction process
- Attend ASC/Camp staff training as required
- Communicate with parents and the finance department about invoicing
- Support the assistants/helpers in preparing learning experiences and materials
- Plan, organise and help supervise camps in the school holidays
- Support the process of welcoming new students to the programmes
- Order, manage and store supplies for the programmes
- Help to problem solve and find solutions in relation to the programmes
- The programmes involve working until 18:30 on school days



Responsibilities in Student Attendance:

- Correspond with parents if a student is absent from After School Care or Camp without prior notice
- Oversee the accurate and timely recording of student attendance

- Take an active role in promoting the School and communicating the ISH mission, vision and values
